WonderBuhle (b.1989) is a South African visual artist from kwaNgcolosi in KwaZulu-Natal. Mbambo received his formal training in 2010 through a visual arts residency at the BAT Centre, a non-profit community arts and culture organisation based in Durban.

He studied Fine Art, under the mentorship of Themba Shibase at the Velobala Apprenticeship Program at Durban University of Technology (2011-2013). In 2016, Mbambo was the recipient of the Bremer Kunststipenium Art Grant. He has participated in group and solo exhibitions in South Africa, the UK, Germany, and Switzerland. Mbambo's most recent solo exhibition "COMFORT" (2020-2021) was held with BKHz Gallery, South Africa. His current body of work, hosted by Galerie Ron Mandos, Amsterdam, is part of a duo exhibition titled "Re(Pose)" (2021). Concluding 2021, WonderBuhle was selected as the Fair Artist for Also Known As Africa Art and Design Fair. March 2022 WonderBuhle debuted his solo exhibition in Amsterdam titled "Unyezi" hosted by Galerie Ron Mandos.
